TRAVEL

Korčula island is approximately three to four hours travel time from either of two airports at [Split](#) or [Dubrovnik](#). Both of these airports service international flights. [Zagreb](#), the capital in the interior of Croatia often a hub for these two coastal airports. For those not familiar with Croatia, and based on the local organizer's travel experience in this area, the recommendation is to arrange flights and transfer to Korč through Dubrovnik. There are, however, other ways to reach Korčula. See transportation information below. Also see the interactive map to give you an orientation to the location of Korčula island relative to Split, Dubrovnik, and points of interest on the island.

TRANSPORTATION

By air to Dubrovnik and transfer to Korčula. Dubrovnik airport serves international flights. Zagreb is a large city in Croatia, but there are also direct flights to Dubrovnik from many European cities.
